Federally qualified health center (FQHC) providers can view a patient's lab result history for tests ordered by other practices, health systems or ordering physicians (for testing performed by Labcorp) giving a **more comprehensive view into a patient's overall health**.

Access to **partial lab results** allows providers to see lab results as they are being finalized, instead of waiting until all lab results are complete, so you can avoid unnecessary delays in patient care.

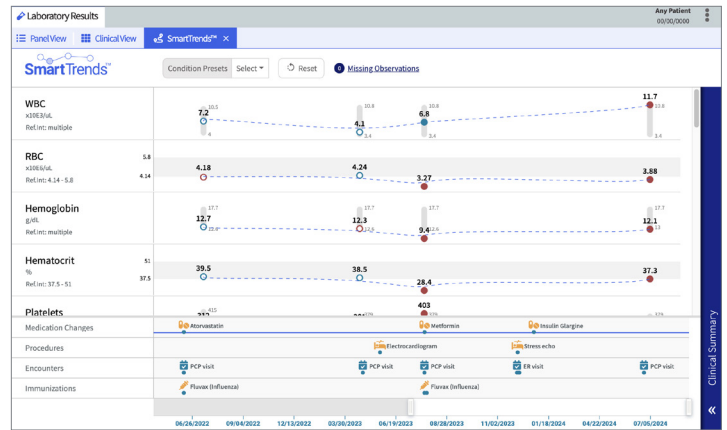
Diagnostic Assistant's add-on testing feature allows your staff to **order additional tests** directly, without needing to contact Labcorp. With order status tracking, you can view the lifecycle progress of your tests ordered at Labcorp regardless of where you order tests online (e.g. EHR/ Labcorp Link).

Lab result PDFs provide **real-time access to each original lab order and result** from outside your FQHC. These PDFs—often helpful for annual Uniform Data System (UDS) reporting—are available in Diagnostic Assistant, even for EHRs that do not support PDFs.

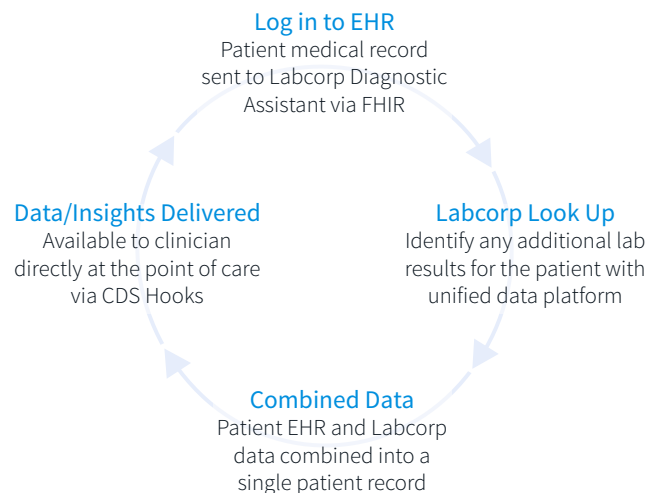


Simple implementation without the IT hassle

As a SMART on FHIR (Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources) app, Diagnostic Assistant doesn't require a large IT investment to add to your EHR, **saving your practice time and money** associated with application integrations.

Using Labcorp Diagnostic Assistant

1. As a provider opens a patient medical record in the EHR, Diagnostic Assistant collects information from the patient's record.
2. Diagnostic Assistant then identifies if the patient had any lab tests performed at Labcorp but ordered outside of the clinician's organization.
3. Those additional Labcorp test results are combined with the information from the EHR to create a single patient record.
4. That single patient record is delivered as a view back into the EHR in real time at the point of care. Without Diagnostic Assistant, the EHR's lab data could be incomplete for many patients, potentially altering treatment plan decisions.
