

General drug testing

General drug testing may be useful when screening for unexpected drug use. This may include, but is not limited to, evaluating underlying causes of medical conditions or behaviors, or screening patients prior to certain treatments. These tests are not designed to monitor compliance with prescribed medications or medication assisted treatment of opioid use disorder.
